

Information for Authors

Journal of Internet Technology accepts original technical articles in all disciplines of Internet Technology & Applications. Manuscripts are submitted for review with the understanding that they have not been published elsewhere. Each author is advised to submit the manuscripts, typewritten, single-spaced, via ScholarOne manuscript site for review. Original drawing need not be sent until the paper is accepted. Once accepted, the manuscript should be submitted as a Microsoft Word or other WORD-processing file and send it through electronic mail along with short biographies and photographs of all the authors. Authors need to pay the publication fee. The author(s) will be responsible for proof-reading the paper. All copyright ownership of the paper will belong to the Journal once it is published. There are seven issues a year for this Journal and reviewing results will be provided within six months for most of the submitted manuscripts. Preparation of Manuscript

Language. The paper should be written in English. It should also include a title, abstract, and keywords in English.

Title page. The title page should be the first page and include the title, all authors' full names, one of the main institution name(s), city name(s), and country name(s) with which they are affiliated, and all authors' e-mail addresses.

The number of the authors should not exceed five.

Abstract. The abstract and keyword should be written in English. It should not consist more than 200 words. 3 ~ 5 keywords should appear at the base of the abstract.

Text. The text of the paper should consist of an Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, and Conclusion. Acknowledgments may be given.

Length. A full paper normally should not exceed 5,000 words. The maximum words number should be below 8,000 words. Any papers over 5,000 words need to pay an extra US\$100 fee before publishing.

Illustrations. All illustrations, including figures and tables, must be professionally rendered and suitable for reproduction. Words, numbers, and symbols should be large and clear enough to remain legible when the figure is reduced to column width (approx. 8 cm). Each table should have a brief, concise title, and all units should be clearly indicated.

Equations and Mathematical Formulas. Equations should be typed and numbered serially on the right-hand side with Arabic numerals in parentheses, and camera-ready. Superscripts and subscripts should be indicated clearly.

Nomenclature. All symbols and units, English and Greek, should be indicated according to their meaning and dimensions in the text and/or in a list in alphabetical order.

Units. SI units are recommended to be used in the text, figures, and tables.

Reference. All references listed must be cited in the article text. Citations in the text are set as Arabic numerals in square brackets. References should be numbered in order of citation at the end of the paper and should appear in the following style:

(1) Journal:

(2) Books:

[2] J. K. Author, *Title of the Book*, Publishing House, year.

(3) Conference Proceedings:

[3] J. K. Author, Title of the Paper, *Unabbreviated Name of Conference*, City, State, year, pp. xxx-xxx.

(4) Theses:

[4] J. K. Author, *Title of the Thesis*, Ph. D. Thesis, Publishing House, City, State, year.

(5) Reports:

[5] J. K. Author, *Title of the Report*, Report No., month, year.
